


The Highlanders Robotics Team



The Highlanders FRC Team 4499 consists of a group of 19 students in 4 schools (Kinard Middle School, Fossil Ridge, Liberty Common and Rocky Mountain High school). We are young men and women with many different interests and experiences. Many of us have been in the FIRST robotics programs for 7 years and some of us are just starting out. We are excited to start our first season with FRC and see what we can do to succeed and have fun!

Our Pre-season Robot




To practice our robot-building skills, we spent November and December building a demo robot. While we were building it, we learned about welding, milling and machining, motors, pneumatics, imaging, CAD and programming.



We received our season's challenge on January 5th—Ultimate Ascent! The game is played by two competing alliances on a 27'x54' field. Each alliance is formed of 3 robots, and they compete as a team to score points by throwing Frisbee discs into goals. The match starts with 15 seconds of autonomous robot action, trying to get discs into goals. This is followed by 2 minutes of drivers controlling the robots and continuing to score goals. Teams can also direct their robots to climb an 10 ft. pyramid for even more points!

The field layout: The red team drivers stand behind the blue goals, and target the red goals and the red pyramid.





The pyramid our robot will climb will actually be 1.5 inch steel pipe, welded at the corners. This PVC version from the Denver kickoff event gives a good perspective, though.




Some ideas for how we can climb.
